How to Determine the Air Filter Size

The easiest way to check is to look at the size printed on your current air filters. Typically, the size is printed somewhere on the air filter frame.

If the size is not available on your current air filter, measure the length, width and thickness of your filter to the nearest 1/8". Write these dimensions down and give us a call at (918-341-6232) and we will help you.

If you do not have an air filter, measure the dimensions of the return air box with the grill open. This is the area where the air filter will fit into the box. Measure the length and width to the nearest 1/8". Write these dimensions down, give us a call and we will help you. Almost all air filters for residences are labeled as 1" thick.

If you think you need a custom size, please contact us.

Notes About Air Filter Sizes

Please understand that the actual size of an air filter is a bit smaller than the size printed on air filters. For example, the actual size of a 14" x 24" x 1" filter is around 13 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 23 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 7/8".

This is done to help ensure that an air filter will fit neatly into it's return air box opening and the grill can be closed.
