

## HOW TO DETERMINE AIR FILTER SIZE

Please understand that the actual size of an air filter is a bit smaller than its nominal or stated size that you order. This is an industry standard. For example, the actual size of a 14" x 24" x 1" filter is approximately 13 3/4" x 23 3/4" x 7/8". This is done to help ensure that an air filter will fit neatly into its opening.

Here are a few tips to help you determine your air filter size:

- Check for size information on the filter you are using now. It should be printed somewhere on the filter frame. Write these numbers below in the nominal column.

OR

- If the dimensions are not printed on the filter frame, measure the length, width and thickness of your filter to the nearest 1/8". Write these numbers below in the actual column.

To calculate the nominal size, add 1/4" to the length and width. Add 1/8" to the thickness. Almost all air filters for homes have a nominal thickness of 1".

OR

- Measure the slot or opening the air filter fits into and choose the appropriate size.
